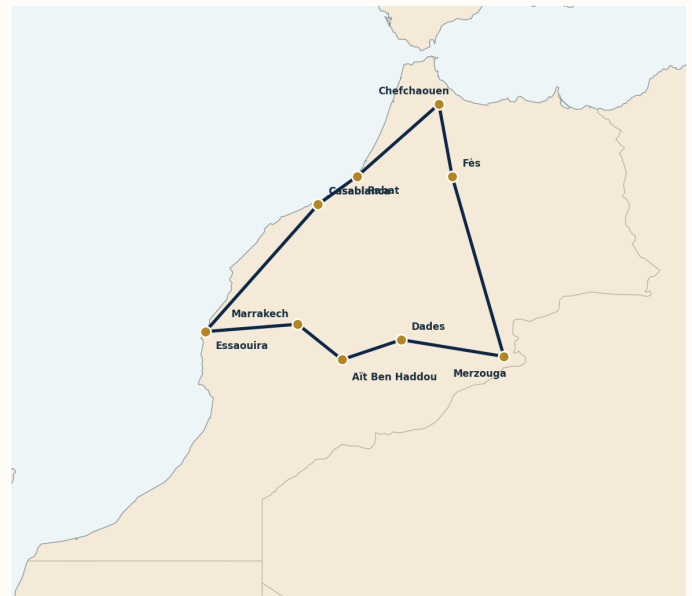

Detailed itinerary

DAY 1

Casablanca -> Rabat

Approx. 1.5-2 hours driving

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Arrival and private transfer to Rabat for a comfortable first night and light sightseeing depending on flight time.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Mint tea, Moroccan pastries, fish or a classic tagine.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A calm start after flying while still adding the capital.

DAY 2

Rabat -> Chefchaouen

Approx. 4 hours driving with stops

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Explore Rabat highlights, then head north into the Rif Mountains and Chefchaouen.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Goat cheese, olives, local bread, mountain tagines and honey.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

Strong visual and cultural contrast in a single day.

DAY 3

Chefchaouen - full day

Minimal driving

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Slow blue-city discovery: lanes, crafts, cafés, viewpoints and time for photography.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Simple northern Moroccan dishes, salads, cheese and olive oil.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A full day protects the quality of one of the country's most atmospheric stops.

DAY 4

Chefchaouen -> Volubilis -> Meknès -> Fès

Approx. 4.5-5.5 hours driving across the day plus visits

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Roman heritage at Volubilis, imperial Meknès and arrival into Fès.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Meknès olives followed by richer Fassi cuisine in the evening.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

An efficient heritage corridor with three distinct historical layers.

DAY 5

Fès private guided day

Local city movement

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

A deeper medina day with a licensed guide, artisan quarters, historic gates and living craft traditions.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Pastilla, harira, briouates, tagines and Fassi pastries.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

The itinerary gives Fès a full day instead of treating it as transit.

DAY 6

Fès -> Merzouga

Approx. 6.5-7.5 hours over the day with scenic and meal stops

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Cross the Middle Atlas, cedar country and Ziz Valley toward Erg Chebbi. End with desert sunset and camp atmosphere.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Mountain apples and grilled dishes en route; medfouna, dates and tagine in the desert.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A long but rewarding landscape transformation from mountain north to Sahara.

Detailed itinerary

Driving windows are approximate and can change with traffic, weather, stops and the pace of your group.

DAY 7

Merzouga -> Todra -> Dades

Approx. 5 hours driving with visits

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Desert sunrise, oasis roads, Todra Gorge and the Dades Valley.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Berber omelette, couscous, tagines and local breads.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A varied day with more stops and less continuous driving.

DAY 8

Dades -> Aït Ben Haddou -> Marrakech

Approx. 5.5-6.5 hours driving with sightseeing

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Ouarzazate region, Aït Ben Haddou and the High Atlas route into Marrakech.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Roadside tagines and, in Marrakech, tanjia, mechoui and refined riad cuisine.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A spectacular transition from kasbah valleys to the Red City.

DAY 9

Marrakech private guided day

Local city movement

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

A well-paced introduction to Marrakech: key monuments, medina lanes, souks and local life with a guide.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Tanjia marrakchia, mechoui, Moroccan salads, orange juice and pastries.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

The guided day creates context before free exploration.

Driving windows are approximate and can change with traffic, weather, stops and the pace of your group.

DAY 10

Marrakech -> Essaouira

Approx. 3 hours driving

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Head west to the Atlantic for a slower afternoon around the old port, ramparts and white-and-blue medina.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Fresh grilled sardines, seafood, fish tagines and argan-region flavours.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

The coast provides a refreshing change after cities, mountains and desert.

DAY 11

Essaouira -> Casablanca

Approx. 4.5-5 hours driving with breaks

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

A relaxed coastal return toward Casablanca and a final evening before departure.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Finish with Atlantic seafood or a contemporary Moroccan dinner.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

A final road day that closes the loop without an overnight sprint to the airport.

DAY 12

Casablanca departure

Airport transfer according to flight time

WHAT YOU'LL EXPERIENCE

Private pickup and transfer to Mohammed V International Airport.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Breakfast at your accommodation when flight timing allows.

WHY THIS DAY WORKS

Airport-to-airport coordination means no last-day transport puzzle.

Is the vehicle private?

Yes. The vehicle and chauffeur are assigned to your booking; vehicle size is matched to your group.

Can we choose room setup?

Yes. Shared-room and single-room preferences can be priced separately. Final room types depend on property availability.

Can the itinerary be adjusted?

Yes. Private travel allows reasonable tailoring before confirmation. Major route changes may alter the price and number of nights.

How does the deposit work?

For eligible departures more than 21 days away, the website can offer a 25% reservation deposit. The remaining balance and due date are shown before payment.
